
<u>INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO LOAD A GREASE GUN AND ATTACH IT TO A GREASE NIPPLE</u>



Instructions for loading the grease gun with grease cartridges

- 1. To change a grease cartridge grip the gun by its head and unscrew the barrel anti-clockwise.
- 2. Draw back the pull rod to the end of the barrel where it should lock onto the ratchet clip.
- 3. A remove cap from the grease cartridge.
 - B insert cartridge into the barrel open end first.
 - C remove ring-pull from the other end of the cartridge.
- 4. Re-attach head of gun to the barrel.
 - A pull back pull rod slightly to release ratchet clip
 - B release ratchet lever
 - C push back the pull rod into the gun barrel
- 5. Press the ventilation valve in the head of the gun to bleed air out of the head.
- 6. Assemble accessories (hose or nozzle tube) and pump lever handle to dispense grease.

Instructions for attaching the 4-jaw connector to the grease nipple

- 1. Clean the grease nipple to avoid contamination getting into the grease.
- 2. Press the 4-jaw connector FIRMLY onto the grease nipple where it should attach with a positive 'clunk'.
- 3. Pump the lever handle to dispense grease through the nipple.
- 4. Twist the grease gun sideways at an angle to detach the 4-jaw connector from the nipple (approx 45°).
- 5. Clean any surplus grease from the nipple and connector.
